We have five new DVD's for rent this month. Yeah, count 'em - FIVE!

All are new ones by Ron Brown. DVD's 240 and 241 comprise a two-volume set on turned wood boxes. D242 features bottle stoppers, and D243 show how to make various types of spinning tops. D71 (that number is correct - it replaces an earlier DVD that was never rented!) is a DVD, but contains data files, including designs, a reference guide for turners, tool safety, scroll saw money making tips, and much more.

The complete DVD listings are being sent to Bill Howard for posting on the club's website, so you can peruse them at your leisure, and decide which one(s) interest(s) you, and have your selection made before the meeting.

We have two new items for sale as a means of support of the library. The first are wax sheets for a buck each. Each one will provide sealing for about 225 slimline pens tubes prior to gluing. The second is a jig I came up with for ensuring proper depth insertion of the twist mechanism into the lower barrel of pens. They are \$6 each. I'll show and explain in more detail at the meeting.

As previously mentioned, the CA glue is here, and ready for sale. The 1-oz. bottles of thin, medium, and thick are \$5 each, and every bottle includes a precision applicator tip. Also, we have the black CA, also in the 1-oz size. It's \$6.

And as a get-started offer, you can purchase one each of the four bottles for \$20, a savings of one big dollar!

If you recall, we're not bringing the big sandpaper box back and forth any more. So once again, if you know what grits/sizes you need, email me and I'll have it ready for your pickup. And since I don't know exactly how much CA glue we'll sell, you might want to let me know ahead of time as to your requirements for CA glue as well.
