Russ Off Center Pendant

Russ uses a Ruth Niles eccentric chuck - you can find it at Ruth Niles bottle stopper website (http://nilesbottlestoppers.com/). The chuck and mandrel by itself costs \$85 and the whole thing (chuck, mandrel, draw bar, extra indexing plate, etc.) is \$110. The draw bar is a threaded rod that secures the #2 Morse taper mandrel in the headstock of the lathe. Russ secures the pendant to the chuck with double sided tape (available at Lowe's for ~\$7). You can also use carpet tape. The pendant for the demo was poplar. He attached it to the jig with double sided tape and turned it round. He then indexed the holes in the chuck to different positions to put accents on the pendant. He also made a small hole (1/4" to 3/8") all the way through the pendant for the lanyard.
